1. Host a Facebook Social Media Benefit fundraiser on your profile, or a Go Fund Me Page.
2. Coordinate a Casual Friday Fundraiser in your office. Invite your coworkers to dress down on a Friday, or sport their green and white attire for awareness, for a small donation fee.
3. Have a garage sale, or community yard sale.... De-cluttering your home never felt so good!
4. Host a car wash in your neighborhood. Charge a small fee and get your community involved.
5. Have a spaghetti dinner or pancake breakfast at your home, town hall... Don't want to have it at your home, many restaurants offer community nights where they will donate 10% or more of sales back to the organization!
6. Know a friend or family member who sells items like Tupperware, Pampered Chef, LuLaRoe, Essential Oils, Jewelry etc... Ask them if they'd be willing to donate the profits of a home show to the organization!
7. Host a Zumbathon at your local gym.
8. Sell cookies, candy bars, or any other food item.
9. Ask your employer if they have a matching gift program.
10. Sell Yankee Candles, just in time for the holidays.

11. Host a Golf Tournament / Running event or other sports platform.
12. Create a concert event in your community.
13. Host a talent show.
